Revocation of Proclamation

- > Emergency revoked by President at any time by a subsequent proclamation Not approve of Parliament
- ➤ President must revoke a proclamation if LS passes a resolution. If LS pass a resolution disapproving its continuation (Previous LS had not control in this regard)
- ➤ By 44th Amendment provides 1/10 of member of LS give a written notice to speaker special sitting within 14 days
- ➤ Ist one is adopted by LS Simple majority & second one need to adopted by special majority

- ➤ Every resolution approving proclamation of president rule passed by either house of Parliament by simple majority.
- ➤ 44th Amendment Beyond 1 year This rule can extended by 6 month approved
- > Proclamation of President Rule may be revoked by president at any time. There is no need of parliamentary approval.
