Chapter No 23: Chief Minister

Chief Minister (CM)
President and Prime minister
 Nominal executive head (Titular or constitutional head)
➢ PM − Real executive head (de facto)
 Similarly, Governor – Nominal executive authority (de jure)
CM – Chief executive authority (de – facto)
Article 164
CM shall be appointed by Governor, on the basis of majority
➢ If a person who is not member of SL can be appointed as CM for 6 months within time − he should
elected to SL failing which he cease to be CM
Solution Governor gone oath to CM, salary & allowance of CM determine by SL
He is chairman of "state planning board".
> He acts as vice – chairman of concerned zonal council by rotation, holding office for period of 1
year at a time.
He act as Member of NDC & ISC (Inter – state council) which both headed by [PM].
He act as crisis manager in chief of state during emergency.
➢ 163 Art: Advice of (CM) & council of Minister to Governor.
> 167 Art: Duty of CM
> 165 Art: Advocate general of state
