Chapter No 23: Chief Minister

Chief Minister (CM)
President and Prime minister
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Nominal executive head (Titular or constitutional head) ➤ PM – Real executive head (de facto) ➤ Similarly, Governor – Nominal executive authority (de jure) ➤ CM – Chief executive authority (de – facto)
Article 164
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ CM shall be appointed by Governor, on the basis of majority ➤ If a person who is not member of SL can be appointed as CM for 6 months within time – he should elected to SL failing which he cease to be CM
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Governor gave oath to CM, salary & allowance of CM determine by SL
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ He is chairman of “state planning board”.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ He acts as vice – chairman of concerned zonal council by rotation, holding office for period of 1 year at a time.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ He act as Member of NDC & ISC (Inter – state council) which both headed by [PM].
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ He act as crisis manager in chief of state during emergency.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 163 Art: Advice of (CM) & council of Minister to Governor. ➤ 167 Art: Duty of CM ➤ 165 Art: Advocate general of state
